AN ORDINANCE IMPOSING A LICENSE TAX UPON THE OWNER AND HARBORER
OF DOGS, FIXING THE AMOUNT OF SAID TAX, REQUIRING A LICENSE FOR
EACH DOG, AUTHORIZING THE DESTRUCTION OF DOGS, PRESCRIBING A PENALTY
FOR VIOLATIONS, ESTABLISHING THE OFFICE OF THE VILLAGE POUND MASTER,
REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 3 OF THE VILLAGE OF CLARK FORK AND ANY
OTHER ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH, AND PROVIDING FOR THE
PUBLICATION OF THIS ORDINANCE. less than one (\$1.00) dollar nor more

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CHAIRMAN AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE
VILLAGE OF CLARK FORK, IDAHO: ^{by created the office of Village}

^{Section 1.} Section 1. No person owning or keeping a dog of either sex
within the corporate limits of the Village of Clark Fork shall
permit any such dog to run at large within the limits of said
Village without first having paid the sum of Three (\$3.00) Dollars
for each male dog and for each spayed female dog and the sum of
Five (\$5.00) Dollars for each unspayed female dog as a license tax
thereon; provided that no license shall authorize the keeping,
owning or harboring of more than one dog. Upon receipt of the
amounts provided herein by the owner of a dog, the Village Pound
Master to be appointed as hereinafter provided, shall issue a
receipt therefor and shall also furnish a substantial tag bearing
the words, "Village Dog Tax" and the year in and for which issued.
The owner or keeper of such dog shall attach such tag to a collar
to be worn by the dog for which such tax was issued during the
time for which the license is to run and the Village Pound Master
shall register such dog in a book kept by him for that purpose, in
which shall be corded the owner's name, the time of payment for
and the expiration of said license and the name, sex and color of
the dog. All licenses shall extend to and expire on the thirtieth
day of April of each year. Provided, further, that such license
shall not allow the running at large of dogs by any harborer or
owner from the fifteenth day of April of each year until the
fifteenth day of June thereof, and, during such period, the running

1 at large of dogs is expressly prohibited and declared to be a
2 misdemeanor and any person owning or harboring such dogs and
3 allowing them to run at large during such period, violating the
4 terms and provisions of this section, upon conviction for such
5 violation shall be fined not less than One (\$1.00) Dollar nor more
6 than Twenty-five (\$25.00) Dollars and costs of prosecution. to the
7
8 Section 2. There is hereby created the office of Village
9 Pound Master who shall be appointed by the Chairman by and with the
10 consent of the Board of Trustees, whose salary and term of
11 employment shall also be fixed by the Chairman by and with the
12 consent of the Board of Trustees and the duties of said officer
13 shall be as prescribed in this ordinance. re or hinder the Village
14
15 Section 3. It shall be the duty of the Village Pound Master
16 to capture and impound any dog or dogs of either sex running at
17 large in the Village of Clark Fork contrary to the provisions of
18 this ordinance. When any dog has thus been captured and impounded,
19 the Village Pound Master shall thereupon cause notice of such
20 capture and impounding to be posted in three of the most conspicuous
21 places in the Village and after at least forty-eight hours from the
22 posting of said notices, shall sell said impounded dog to the
23 highest bidder and pay the amount received into the Village Treasury.
24
25 Section 4. If the owner or harbinger of any such dog who is
26 thus taken by the Village Pound Master because of failure to pay
27 the license tax on said dog as hereinabove provided, desires to
28 redeem said dog, he may do so upon payment of the license tax and
29 a fee of One (\$1.00) Dollar to be paid to said Village Pound Master.
30 Dogs remaining unsold and unredeemed shall be destroyed by the
31 Village Pound Master in as humane a manner as possible. in one issue

33 Section 5. If any owner or keeper of an unspayed female dog,
34 shall knowingly permit her to run at large while in heat, not-
35

1 withstanding such person may have a license for such dog as
2 provided in this ordinance, such person shall upon conviction
3 thereof, for each and every offense, be fined in the sum of not
4 less than One (\$1.00) Dollar nor more than Ten (\$10.00) Dollars
5 and costs of prosecution.

6 Section 6. The Village Pound Master shall be entitled to the
7 sum of One (\$1.00) Dollar for each and every dog impounded and
8 sold or destroyed by him under the provisions of this ordinance,
9 said sums to be audited and paid out of the Village Treasury.
10 All monies received for licenses as provided herein shall be paid
11 to the Village Treasurer.

12 Section 7. No person shall interfere or hinder the Village
13 Pound Master in the performance of his duties and any person who
14 does so interfere or hinder said officer in the performance of
15 his duties shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon con-
16 viction thereof shall be fined not less than Five (\$5.00) Dollars
17 together with the costs of prosecution.

18 Section 8. Any person being the owner or harbinger of any dog
19 within the limits of the Village of Clark Fork who has not paid the
20 license tax provided herein, shall be deemed guilty of a mis-
21 demeanor, and upon conviction thereof shall be fined not less than
22 Five (\$5.00) Dollars nor more than Ten (\$10.00) Dollars and the
23 costs of prosecution.

24 Section 9. Ordinance No. 9 of the Village of Clark Fork and
25 any other ordinances in conflict herewith shall be and the same
26 hereby are repealed.

27 Section 10. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force
28 from and after its passage, approval and publication in one issue
29 of the Sandpoint News-Bulletin, a newspaper of general circulation
30 in the Village of Clark Fork, which is hereby designated as the
31 official newspaper of the Village for the publication of this
32 ordinance.

1 Passed under suspension of the statutes and rules and duly

3 meeting of the Board of Trustees of the Village of Clark Fork held
4 on the 7th day of May, 1951.
