Minutes of the 4/13/26 Clark Fork Regular City Council Meeting

Mayor Schenck called the April 13, 2026, Regular Meeting of the City Council to order at 6:00 p.m.

ADDITIONS TO THE AGENDA

The Mayor requested to add consideration of the Phase Three project going out to bid to the agenda, stating that the Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ) had approved the plans after public notice was posted.

Charles Mortensen and Sammy Berryman, representing the Monarch Grind cyclist group, were present to request road closures the day of their bike race on June 27, 2026. The Council indicated that they would likely need to go through the Idaho State Highway District since the road closure requested was adjacent to Highway 200. Alternate routes were recommended and Council Member White suggested using his property as a starting point, which would eliminate the need for road closures. This seemed agreeable to all parties. No action was needed by Council.

J. Set Date for Zoning Workshop.

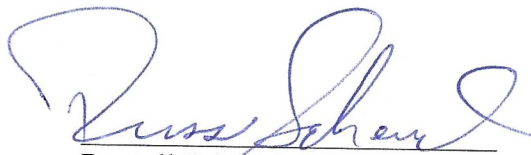
The zoning workshop was set for Wednesday April 22 at 6:00 p.m.
