Minutes of the 6/8/26 Clark Fork Regular City Council Meeting

Mayor Schenck called the June 8, 2026, Regular Meeting of the City Council to order at 6:12 p.m.

Pledge of Allegiance: The Mayor led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Roll Call of Council Members: Sharon Banning, Jay White, Vicki Woodward and Tim Yetter were present, constituting a quorum. Councilman White had to leave just prior to item A. Quorum still obtained.

CONSENT AGENDA: ACTION ITEM.

Motion to Approve the Consent Agenda:

Council Member Woodward moved to approve the Consent Agenda. Council Member Banning seconded the motion. All in favor. Motion carried unanimously.

New Business:

A. Discussion of Change Order #2 and Pay Request No 6 for Phase Two Water System, ACTION ITEM.

Dan Remmick was present to update the Council on the changes on Phase Two of the water system. Due to additional excavation and backfill for increased pipe depth, time and materials for trench dewatering and encountering previously unknown waterlines and other obstacles during the course of construction, The amount to complete Phase two of the project is \$302,515.75. LaRiviere is requesting \$274,54133 with the remainder due upon completion of Phase Two.

Council Member Woodward moved to approve the Mayor signing the change order #2 and pay request #6 to La Riviere as submitted for the Phase Two Project. Council Member Banning seconded.
