

RESOLUTION NO. 2026-5

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLARK FORK, IDAHO,
ADOPTING THE BONNER COUNTY MULTI-JURISDICTIONAL
ALL-HAZARDS MITIGATION PLAN

WHEREAS, the City of CLARK FORK recognizes that natural and human-caused hazards pose a threat to the lives, property, economy, and environment of the community; and

WHEREAS, the Disaster Mitigation Act of 2000 (Public Law 106-390) encourages local governments to develop and maintain hazard mitigation plans to reduce future losses and improve community resilience; and

WHEREAS, the City of CLARK FORK actively participated with Bonner County and participating jurisdictions in the development and update of the Bonner County Multi-Jurisdictional All-Hazards Mitigation Plan; and

WHEREAS, the Plan identifies hazards affecting the community, assesses vulnerabilities, establishes mitigation goals and objectives, and recommends mitigation actions designed to reduce the impacts of future disasters; and

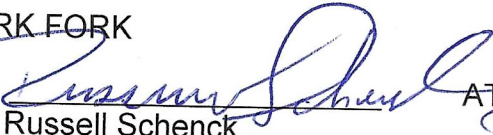
WHEREAS, adoption of the Plan demonstrates the City's commitment to reducing risks from natural hazards and supports continued eligibility to apply for FEMA Hazard Mitigation Assistance grant programs, subject to applicable federal and state requirements.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of CLARK FORK, Idaho, as follows:

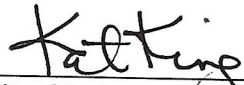
1. The City Council hereby adopts the Bonner County Multi-Jurisdictional All-Hazards Mitigation Plan, including the jurisdiction-specific annex for the City of CLARK FORK, as the City's official hazard mitigation plan.
2. The City shall use the adopted Plan as a guide for identifying and implementing hazard mitigation activities that reduce the impacts of future disasters whenever practical and financially feasible.
3. The City designates the Mayor, or his/her designee, as the official responsible for coordinating implementation, maintenance, and future updates of the Plan on behalf of the City.
4. The City agrees to participate with Bonner County and other participating jurisdictions in future reviews and updates of the Plan as required to maintain the Plan's effectiveness and FEMA approval.
5. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its passage and approval.
